

2021 TRAP LEAGUE RULES

The Mondovi Conservation Club is a member run club. It takes everyone doing their part for things to run smoothly.

Fees

- **Sponsor fees** = \$35. Please pay sponsor fees to Becky Wright.
- **Shooting tickets:** 1 ticket = \$4; Book of 10 tickets = \$38
- **Shells** = \$8/box. Due to the current ammo shortage, shooters will be limited to purchasing 4 boxes of shells per day to be shot at the MCC trap range.
- **Membership:** All shooters must be paid members of the Club. Membership must be paid by Week 4. If a shooter is delinquent on their membership after Week 4, their scores will not count.
- Youth shooters shooting on a team in the regular league are required to pay shooting fees.

Shooting

- **No** shootbacks will be allowed after Week 2. No Exceptions!
- Shooters may shoot ahead as many weeks as they want. This eliminates the need for shootbacks.
- Shooting hours:
 - Wednesday 5:30PM – 10:00PM with last sign up at 9:00PM; trap closed at 11:00PM
 - Saturday 12:00PM – 3:00PM

Range Duties

- Teams are required to have at least two (2) workers present to work on both Wednesday and Saturday of their work weeks. If a team does not have at least 2 workers show up, the team scores for that week will not be counted.
- Committee member in charge will pick up or make arrangements for someone else to pick up the food and money bag from Buzz's on Wednesday.
- Keys for the trap houses are in the money bag.
- Responsibilities
 - Run the bar
 - Manage shooting sheets and announcing shooters
 - Official/scoring rounds have shooter # and week # that is being shot
 - Every shooter has a shooting ticket
 - Completed/scored sheet are put in the drawer behind the bar
 - Load trap houses – To reduce the chance for injury when loading traps, team captains are responsible for ensuring all team members are shown how to release the traps prior to loading between rounds.
 - Empty all outside trash containers each day
 - Empty inside trash and aluminum can containers as needed.

- Tie aluminum can bags closed and put into the trailer.
- Sweep the trap building
- When closing trap houses at the end of the night, unplug and/or turn off all electrical components.
- If wind conditions allow, burn cardboard at the end of the night.

Youth/Junior League

- Ages 12-18 w/hunter education complete; 18 year olds must still be in high school
- League starts Week 1 and is 10 weeks long
- Shooters are provided a book of 10 shooting tickets and a punch card for 10 boxes of shells
- Shooters pay for practice rounds
